THEATRE

I am going to Quincy Community Theatre to see a show.



LOBBY

The theatre lobby at Quincy Community Theatre is big. When I look up, I will see a lot of windows and a big white staircase.

I will walk into the lobby to get to the theatre where I will see the show. People may be standing around before entering the theatre.

BOX OFFICE

TICKET SCANNER

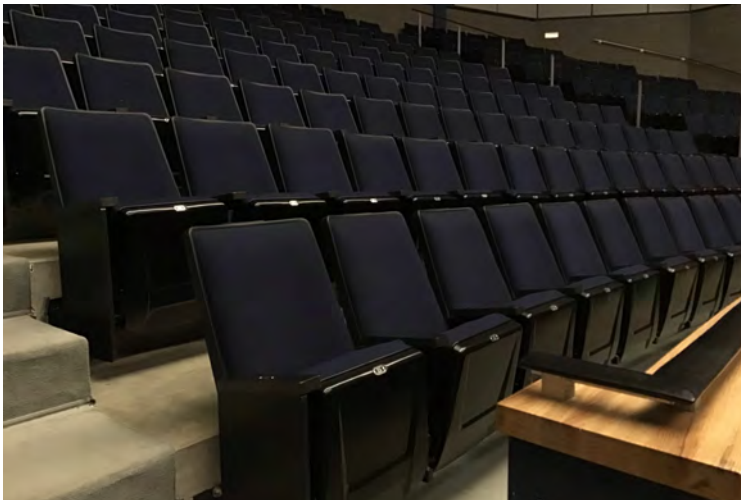
The ticket scanner will take the ticket to scan with a machine that beeps. After the beeping sound, my family and I can go into the theatre.

The theatre usher is a friendly helper. I can ask the theatre usher for help.

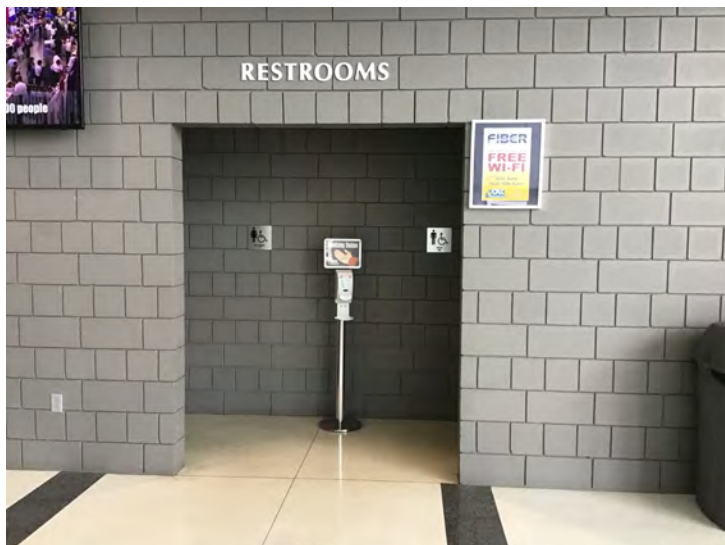
The theatre usher will give me a stagebill so I can learn more about the show. If I don't want a stagebill, I can say "no thank you".

The actors will talk and sing songs during the show. I can cover my ears if the sound is too loud.

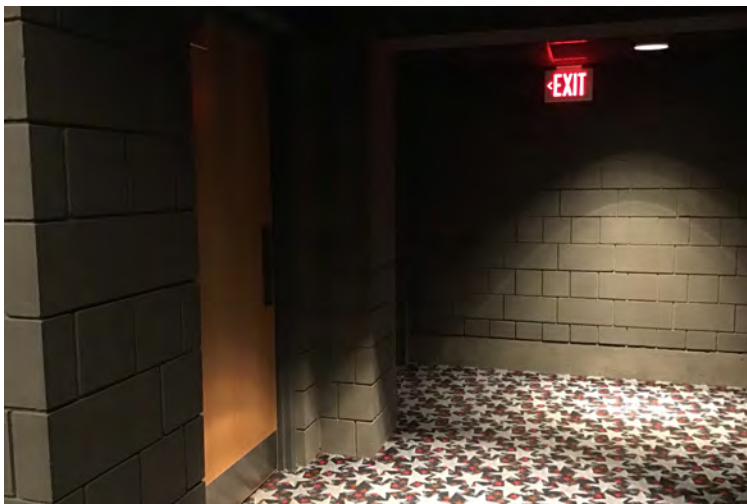
The other people who are watching might laugh or clap during the play. If I like the show, I can laugh or clap too. I can cover my ears if the sound is too loud.
