#### Outreach Workshops

- Workshops are 45 minutes long and can accommodate up to 30 students at a time.
- All workshops are led by a professional teaching artist who visits the classroom.
- Each workshop addresses a theatrical topic (acting, pantomime, improvisation, etc.)
- All lesson plans are in alignment with National Core Arts Standards and Illinois Standards in English Language Arts and Social/Emotional Learning.

#### QCT On-the-Road

- QCT On-the-Road performances are approximately 45 minutes long and can accommodate up to 200 students at a time.
- QCT performers will arrive one hour before show time to prepare the scenery, costumes, and all other elements of a play! (QCT On-the-Road shows are best when performed in a large space, such as a cafeteria or gymnasium.)
- Our touring shows are interactive, meaning your students will get a chance in the spotlight!
- The 2017 QCT On-the-Road show is *American Fairy Tales*, an adaptation of stories by L. Frank Baum. *American Fairy Tales* is available from May 1-June 9.

#### Theatre Tours

- Theatre Tours are one hour long and accommodate 24 students per group. (If your group is larger than 24, you will be split in multiple groups who tour at the same time.)
- All tours take place inside our theatre facility in the Oakley-Lindsay Center. Students will get a special behind-the-scenes look at how we create our productions. They will be able to view scenery, costumes, props, and lighting equipment used in whichever production is running at the time of your tour. Tours also explore theatrical history and legend.
- At this time, QCT is not able to provide transportation to or from theatre tours.
